CARING: To be sensitive to the well-being of others.

HONEST: To tell the truth. To act in such a way that I am worthy of trust.

RESPECTFUL: To treat others as I would have them treat me. To value the worth of every person, including myself.

RESPONSIBLE: I will take responsibility for my own behavior and obligations.

My commitment to camp is to:

FOLLOW THE BUDDY SYSTEM: Stay with a buddy always, warn of danger, and call or go for help when it is needed.

PARTICIPATE IN ALL ACTIVITIES: I will contribute to the camp community by sharing my ideas and participating. I will do my share of daily responsibilities for camp living.

BE SAFE, BE AWARE: I will listen carefully to all orientations and will observe safety precautions for all activities during the camp session.

TAKE CARE OF MYSELF: If anything occurs at camp that makes me feel uncomfortable or unsafe, including the behavior of other campers, I will immediately tell an adult I trust.
